Correspondence In/Out:

President's Report:

- Father's Day Breakfast, everything went smoothly and thanks to the teachers who assisted on the BBQ
- Unity and Jo met with a group including State Transit & North Sydney Council and they want to provide a bus service to APPS – 1 service in morning & 3 in afternoon linked with existing School Bus Services travelling through to St Leonards, Linfield East and Lane Cove. Any school child or accompanying adult can travel on the school bus. The scheduling can be reviewed again next year.
- APPS didn't get the Local Community Grant (Service NSW) for the playground equipment however Flynn is looking to apply for another grant
- Spring Soiree this Thursday – Coffee/Tea and cake will be ordered and sold on the night with all proceeds going to the schools performing arts program

Principal's Report:
(Mrs Unity Taylor-Hill)

- Amy consulted with the P&C to apply for the school chaplaincy program, this person would be not faith based but a social worker/wellbeing learning support position – up to 3 days a week for 3 years and APPS can determine what they will be involved in during this time. APPS can appoint via a provider – not just an allocation to ensure school fit. All in attendance agree to proceeding
- Next week 'tell them from me' survey will be sent home. Teachers & Students in Y4, 5 & 6 complete the survey as well as parents from all years across the school
- Starting 2020 staffing process – 130 enrolled for Kindergarten 2020 – close to 700 students in total across the school – when we get to 700 students APPS get a second deputy
- Upcoming Events: Student led conferences next week, 2020 K playgroup last week of T3, Stage 2 camp in T4, Stage 3 High School transition coming up, Y6 farewell, Y2 Swimming in T4 & end of year disco
- Stage 3 are holding a Vivid on 25 September as part of their program – lighting artist coming to workshop with them

- Recent invoices paid include event expenses for 'We are APPS' night and the water bottle refill stations now installed
