Since the last report (to 9 February 2025) we have received \$1,294.34 in incomprised of:  \$1,144.34 in bank account interest; and  \$150 in second hand uniform sales  We have paid expenses totalling \$49.98, including:		

\$14.98 in bank fees (smart mini);

\$35 for our Xero accounting software subscription

Our net cash balance therefore increased by \$1,244.36, bringing our overall cash position to \$357,047.92.

- The Rosalind Street pedestrian crossing has been endorsed by North Sydney Council. A start date for the work has not been set yet however it was agreed in the NSC meeting that a 'Children Crossing' sign should also be installed near the crossing.
