**President's Report:** (Sarah Robinson)

- **Colour run** – last month for fundraising and will do the run early next year and will be able to select gifts till end of the month
- **Envirobank** – back in Nov!!
- **HEPA air purifiers for classrooms** – P&C federation. Department of Education oversees reviewing and approving if the school requires filters. So even if P&C wants to fund, they can't unless federation approves (due to safety of ongoing maintenance). Lots of good info in the latest info from Unity.

**Principal's Report:** (Mrs Unity Taylor-Hill)

- **End of year planning**
  - Developing student reports, new guidelines from Department with similar to Semester 1 last year to take into account learning from home.
  - School plan evaluation final year on achievements. A few surveys will be sent to get family input.
  - Term 4 events
    - Year 6 leadership team selection and refresh of the process
    - Year 6 farewells and kindy orientation hoping that Covid restrictions will be lifted in Dec.
    - School photo dates sent (subject to Covid)
- **Covid return level 3** – communicated by Unity.
  - Special Covid newsletter sent with all the info including
  - Student check-ins to give personalised info for the teachers to support all needs.
  - Staggered timetables in place and playground end of day for those with multiple children.
  - Info on pick ups will be provided and for siblings to meet post school
  - Minimise teachers moving between classes and classes mixing.
  - **Staff vaccination** – All staff (including TeamKids, Canteen etc) are vaccinated prior to the deadline.
  - **Mask wearing** – mandatory for all adults and strongly recommended for all students. School will look to see how they can support the kids wearing masks. DoE will provide masks if students don't have.
  - Strict **limits** for people entering the school and significant increase of **cleaning** including high touch areas.
  - Ordered low touch bins so being very proactive
  - **Team Kids** – continue to have no parents on the ground.
  - **Filtration** – understands concerns and will share report. Natural ventilation is the most effective way and APPS is very well set up with lots of outdoor options and natural ventilations. Less effective when windows can't be opened is filtration. May be a need to put purifiers e.g., during bushfire season.

- **NAPLAN** – 2021 results go out in first week of term 4. NAPLAN online allows for stream test, so questions adapt to target student abilities. Data is allowing the school to focus on where we need to focus to improve cohort results. Year 4 and Year 6 also completed check-in assessment earlier in the year. Will do another check-in assessment in Y3-6 to see how students are doing.
- **Team kids** – department waived license fees to Team kids due to learning from home. Team Kids have said they will donate some of this back to the P&C.
